Challenges facing small businesses in the Windsor area are similar to those in other parts of the province.

A Roundtable discussion was held with Ontario Chamber of Commerce President Allan O'Dette this morning at the Windsor Chamber offices.

A number of small businesses from various sectors were represented at the session.

The top issues were the cost of doing business like electricity, red tape and the municipal and provincial level as well as challenges with the infrastructure.

O'Dette says this session is part of an information gathering process: "we've launched a campaign titled, Small Business, Too Big To Ignore and we're trying to work collaboratively with the Ontario Ministry of Economic Development and understand what the issue and obstacles that small and medium size enterprise face and what are the solutions"

He says it's easy to find fault, but that doesn't get you anywhere.

O'Dette says this process is aimed at providing answers and not just complaining about the problems.
