Windsor, ON – The Windsor-Essex Regional Chamber of Commerce is hosting a Distinguished Speaker Luncheon with the Premier of Ontario Kathleen Wynne on Friday, November 22, 2013 from 11:30 a.m. – 1:30 p.m. at the Caboto Club, located at 2174 Parent Ave.

The Premier will speak on “Job One Ontario,” which outlines her plan to grow the economy and create jobs by investing in people, investing in infrastructure, and supporting a dynamic business environment.

“We are looking forward to hosting the Premier and hearing her plan for Ontario,” said Windsor-Essex Regional Chamber of Commerce President and CEO Matt Marchand.

Premier Wynne is Ontario’s 25th Premier and the first woman to serve in that role. She was first elected to the Ontario legislature in 2003 as the MPP for Don Valley West, and she became the leader of the Ontario Liberal Party in January, 2013. She has focused on introducing practical progressive solutions throughout her extensive political career, including roles as Ontario’s Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, Minister of Aboriginal Affairs, Minister of Transportation, and Minister of Education.
